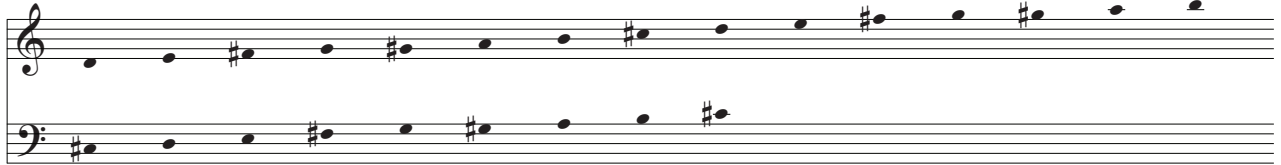

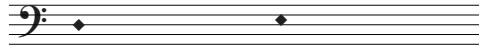

* Two octave choirs should play all upstemmed notes at one dynamic level softer than the downstemmed notes whenever both are present. When played in a massed ringing setting with groups ringing 3 or more octaves, the upstemmed notes can be played at the same dynamic level as the downstemmed notes.

An edition for 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7 octaves is available, code CGB1029. The two editions are compatible for massed ringing.
